Description

The Buyer/Planner is responsible for the execution and continuous improvement of the planning/order fulfillment process for one or several product lines covering demand planning and order fulfillment as well as supply planning and materials replenishment.

Primary Responsibilities (demand planning & order fulfillment)

- Manages order backlog after order entry, ensuring that orders flow through the order fulfillment cycle
- Manages inventory by commodity
- Manages open POs and suppliers by commodity
- Validates order configuration, maintains and communicates order delivery dates
- Plans Production parts in partnership with the Manufacturing Production requirement.
- Responsible for driving on-time delivery to the customer
- Partners with other functions (Manufacturing, Engineering & Finance) to resolve/escalate any issues preventing on-time order fulfillment
- Partners with Finance to monitor accurate revenue recognition on assigned orders

Primary Responsibilities (supply planning & materials replenishment)

- Executes planning process, creates purchase orders and communicates with suppliers
- Reviews and resolves material shortages daily
- Reviews open purchase orders daily, expediting past due orders and obtaining supplier promise dates.
- Ensures materials are available on-time while at the same time minimizing inventory.

- Maintains accuracy of planning parameters in the MRP system
- Drives improvement in supplier on-time delivery
- Interacts with key suppliers

- Able to perform duties with minimal supervision
