Responsibilities

- Architect a global spares fulfillment system that will meet worldwide parts availability and turn goals
- Work with Field Engineers, technical support, production demand planners, and NPI teams to establish spares kits stocking strategy and execution and reorder points
- Optimize inventory and match supply to demand, to maximize turns and parts availability globally and in the factory
- Meet Services Spares availability goals, on-time spares supply, inventory targets, and target stocking level replenishment cycle time in the factory and worldwide depots
- Lead the day-to-day operations of planning professionals and provide high-level direction and support
- Review and oversee loading of demand for all spares, consumables, retrofits, and field change orders into MRP system to meet customer and company goals
- Manage obsolescence and inventory aging to minimize inventory scrap
- Negotiate, recommend, and prioritize spares & consumables stocking strategy based on demand requirements, lead time, new product introduction, and other supply chain risks
